

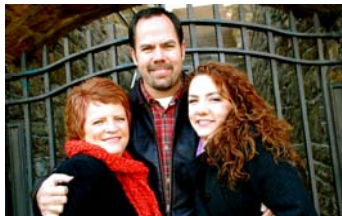

This past month at **Stephen F. Austin State University**, three Christian professors shared their journeys at a meeting sponsored by Campus Crusade:

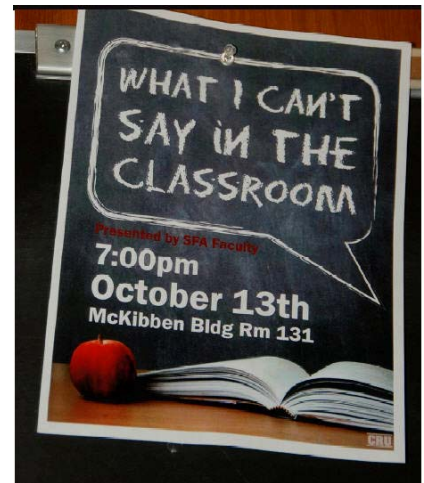
- In losing a husband to lung cancer, and how God sustained her;
