Jack directs a national ministry to the 70,000 veterans now enrolled as undergrads:

- Some lack academic preparation, and high school may have been 6 or more years ago;
- Many are recovering from physical or mental injuries;
- The stress of this unfamiliar life often reveals spiritual needs.

"Now that they are veterans, all of them have a story; most have *many* stories, and quite often they are messy and painful. And we can come alongside them, be the 'battle buddy' to help bear the burden until the vet can lay it down at the feet of Jesus."
